***April 2008 Incident Log***

The following is a summary of calls received by Upper Mountain Volunteer Fire Company during the month of April 2008. Upper Mountain responded to 74 calls for the month while providing Fire, Rescue, and Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Life Support (ALS) Emergency Medical Services in its response area and to other communities through mutual aid requests by surrounding agencies.
