Lewiston, New York**

May 2008 Incident Log

The following is a summary of calls received by the Upper Mountain Volunteer Fire Company during the month of May 2008. Upper Mountain responded to 76 calls for the month, bringing the yearly run total to 428 calls, while providing Fire, Rescue, and Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Life Support (ALS) Emergency Medical Services in its response area and to other communities through mutual aid requests by surrounding agencies.
